Save the Date! 12/12/15 – Our AHG Troop will be participating in Wreaths Across America, a chance to honor those who have served and defended our country. Our troop will attend the ceremony at the United States Soldiers' and Airmen's Home National Cemetery, in Washington, D.C.

Wreaths Across America Fundraising

Between now and Thanksgiving we plan to sell sponsorship of wreaths to be laid. The wreaths are \$15, and \$5 of that goes towards our troop. The other \$10 pays for the wreaths to be laid at the cemetery. People interested in sponsoring can choose to sponsor a wreath in honor of someone to whom a card will be sent, or in memory of someone whose name will be posted on the online memory wall. We are asking each girl to sell sponsorship of a minimum of 4 wreaths to meet our planned fundraising goal for this year.

We will have more information and sponsorship sheets for the girls at our meeting on October 25th. Funds raised for the troop will go toward our benevolent fund to support the uniform and registration costs for girls whose families are unable to afford it, as well as activities for all the girls, like our spring camping trip. This is our main fundraiser for the program year 2015-2016.
